**Subject:** Imaging in Prostate Cancer

Advanced imaging is becoming more important in the diagnosis and treatment of Prostate Cancer. Dr. Fabio Almeida will discuss the various options for imaging, from bone scans to newer methods such as C11-Acetate PET/CT and Gallium-68-PSMA PMSA. He will also discuss new radiotherapy options on the horizon.

Dr. Almeida graduated from The Chicago Medical School in 1991. He completed a combined residency and fellowship in Internal Medicine and Nuclear Medicine at the University of San Francisco and is certified by the American Board of Nuclear Medicine and the Board of Nuclear Cardiology. He was in academic practice at the University of California, San Francisco and private practice until 2005, then Assistant Professor of Radiology & Radiation Oncology, and subsequently served as the Director of Nuclear Medicine for the University of Arizona Medical Center in Tucson Arizona. He has published several peer-reviewed journal articles and book chapters radiology, oncology, cardiology, nutritional and information science. Dr. Almeida is a fellow of the Integrative Medicine Program at the University of Arizona where he has also studied integrative/functional medicine, herbal medicine, nutrition, fitness, and stress management and is a life-long student of healthcare innovation. In 2010, Dr. Almeida established the Phoenix Molecular Imaging facility in Phoenix Arizona which provides unique diagnostic imaging and treatment solutions for cancer patients.
