Thomas K. Lee, M.D., Ph.D. Brief Bio:

I am currently an Associate Clinical Professor in Pathology at UC Irvine, with secondary appointment in the department of Urology as well. My main area of practice is urologic pathology (2/3 of cases), but also cover other organs such as breast, soft tissue, gastrointestinal and gynecological pathology (1/3 combined). I am the director of the pathology residency program at UC Irvine too.

I was born in Brazil and moved to NY at the age of 13, and went to college at the University of Rochester (BA in Biology and Economic) and received a PhD in Toxicology as well. I went on to medical school at the George Washington University and completed my residency in anatomic pathology with a fellowship in urologic pathology at the Johns Hopkins University Hospital under Drs. Jonathan Epstein and George Netto, with an additional general surgical pathology fellowship at the Stanford University Hospital. I practiced in Seattle, WA at the Swedish Medical Center for 4.5 years before moving to UC Irvine in January of 2015.
